## Project Learn Belize UPDATE

### Teacher to Teacher Exchange: March 2008

A first endeavor for *Project Learn Belize: Teacher to Teacher Exchange* occurred March 13 – 19, 2008. Dr. Hazel Brauer, Adjunct Professor in the Teacher Education Department, traveled with Dr. Dillon, the *Project's* director, to Sacred Heart School in Dangriga.



After two days of observing teachers and students in their classrooms, Dr.

Brauer, a reading specialist for the Jefferson School District (Daly City), conducted a day and a half workshop on “best practices” in children’s literacy for the faculty of Sacred Heart. Twenty-six faculty members and administrators gave up the first two days of their spring break to attend the workshop.



Appreciation for Dr. Brauer’s presentations was best summed up in their unanimous response, “Please come back and teach us more!” Vice Principal Eunice Nunez echoed these sentiments: “with such excellent training for our teachers, as Hazel gave us, we can easily become a model school for the entire country.” Along with contributions from *Project Learn Belize*, additional funding for the *Exchange* was provided by a USF Jesuit Community Foundation Grant.
